THE BETHANY BLUEPRINT

In his book, Just Like Jesus, Max Lucado asked the question,

***“What if, for twenty-four hours,
Jesus wakes up in your bed, walks in your
shoes, lives in your house, assumes your
schedule?”***

Your boss becomes His boss, your mother becomes His mother, your pains become His pains? With one exception, nothing about your life changes. Your health doesn't change. Your circumstances don't change. Your schedule isn't altered. Your problems aren't solved. Only one change occurs. *What if for one day and one night, Jesus lives your life with His heart?*

The authors of Scripture have asked us to consider the same things as Max Lucado throughout our Parish Theme this year: ***What if we had a heart like His?***

This year has had no shortage of events that could make the heart ache. Nationally we've continued to see a dismal economy and many are still without or continue to lose jobs. Personally we know loved ones who have lost health, wealth or life itself. Congregationally we've seen some of our ministries and ministers experience decline and redirection.

Through it all we've also seen the heart of our God, and it is good! His faithfulness never fails. His ear is always open. His arms always extended. His hand always bestowing blessings. Why, this year alone He has, through His people, helped to pay off our mortgage, replace the gym floor and received estate gifts helping us tackle potential deficits. **His heart is good, gracious and generous, and He is in the business of giving us ones like His.**

Our Sunday School needs volunteers and students to ignite its spiritual revival!

Christ is King! Sunday School used to be a bigger part of the ministry here. We had healthy attendance, offerings were plentiful and parents willingly volunteered to lead Sunday School classes. Attendance and stewardship is falling. How did Sunday School get to this point? Here are some thoughts to consider:

- ✚ Sunday School is losing ground. As parents, some may say that we have allowed the importance of youth sports programs to take precedence over taking advantage of an opportunity for our children to share biblical lessons with their friends, friends they may only see on Sundays, and we fail to share the Good News with newcomers to God's Love.
- ✚ Has our Sunday School simply hit hard times like the current economy? Our goal is to turn it around and revitalize our teaching staff and strive to improve our discipleship efforts. As the Superintendent, I am currently reviewing my commitment to Sunday School.

During the past nine months grades 4-5-6 made a valiant leap towards revitalization. There will be some minor adjustments within this age group, but nothing outrageous. It will take some getting used to, and after a few more months it will flourish. **Our Sunday School needs volunteers and students to ignite its spiritual revival.**

If you know a child that needs to learn about Jesus or a child wanting to know more, send him or her to Sunday School. It's for just a short period of time but the reward will last forever. If you are a busy person, have a heart for Jesus, enjoy seeing someone smile and like to receive hugs, step it up, kick off your slippers and put on your running shoes. There is a spot for you in the Sunday School Discipleship Program at Bethany. Start out small, teach a 2-week block THIS Summer, find a friend to team up with and teach every other month. **Summer needs are highlighted, pg. 2 of this Chimes.**

Ministry of Outreach News...

I can't tell you how many times I have heard deeply committed followers of Christ say that they just can't share the message of Jesus with others. The list of excuses is lengthy, the reasons are well articulated, but Scripture tells us that we all have been given a commission to bring the Gospel to all nations.

One big excuse I hear is, "I don't have the gift of evangelism." That may be true, but it does not excuse you from sharing the message. Every follower of Jesus has the capacity for the light of Jesus to shine in their lives. Pastor Kevin Harney in his book *Organic Outreach for Ordinary People* says the following:

Think about it this way. Some people have the spiritual gift of giving (1Cor. 13:3). They are generous beyond the norm and share their resources freely. It comes naturally to them. But all Christians are called to give with generous hearts and make their resources available to God (2 Cor. 9:7). We can't say, "I don't have the gift of giving, so it's okay for me to live a selfish and stingy life."

Other followers of Jesus have the God-given gift of compassion (Rom 12:8). They feel at a deeper level, care authentically, and naturally come alongside people in times of pain, loss and need. These people minister the grace of Jesus in powerful ways. Does this mean the Christians who don't have this gift are free to be hard-hearted and insensitive? Of course not. We are all called to show tenderness and sensitivity. Some have the gift of compassion, but all believers are called to show mercy.

The same is true of evangelism. Some have the gift and it comes naturally to them. But all of us are

called to live salty lives that cause others to thirst for Jesus' living water. Every follower of Jesus can reflect God's light so that others will see Jesus' glory.

Be encouraged! You really can reach out and share the good news of Jesus naturally. Whether you've been talking about your favorite shampoo, that restaurant you love, or your favorite sports teams, you've been practicing already.

Are you looking for a way to share the good news of Jesus? May I suggest starting where you already have an audience. You can start at work, with your neighbors, or at the grocery store. Find ways to share about the confidence you have in Jesus. Don't worry about what others will think, you may be surprised at the results.

If you are looking for other ways to help, I encourage you to consider serving in one of the many ministries at Bethany including **Thrivent Builds with Habitat for Humanity on June 11th**. Perhaps it's a Mission trip to Alaska in 2011 or to India in 2012 that is right for you. You can always volunteer for Vacation Bible School June 20-24, or serve as an usher, lector or greeter or staff the nursery on Sunday. You can help fold the bulletins, set up communion, or sell SCRIP.

There are plenty of opportunities to share your faith in Jesus in words and in actions. Please feel free to contact me if you need some help finding a place to serve passionately and share intentionally.
